HISTORY AND ARCHITECTURAL STYLE

The Hsinchu Train Station, which is the oldest train station in Taiwan, was built by a German-trained Japanese architect. And it was completed on March 31st, 1913.

It is a fusion of Baroque style and Gothic style, so there are many special designs in this building.

The armored clock tower and four-sided clock

The tower looks like a warrior's helmet, and it is a single-story building that was built during the Japanese colonial period. And the four-sided clock is connected to other clocks in the station, that allowed time to be unified in this era.
